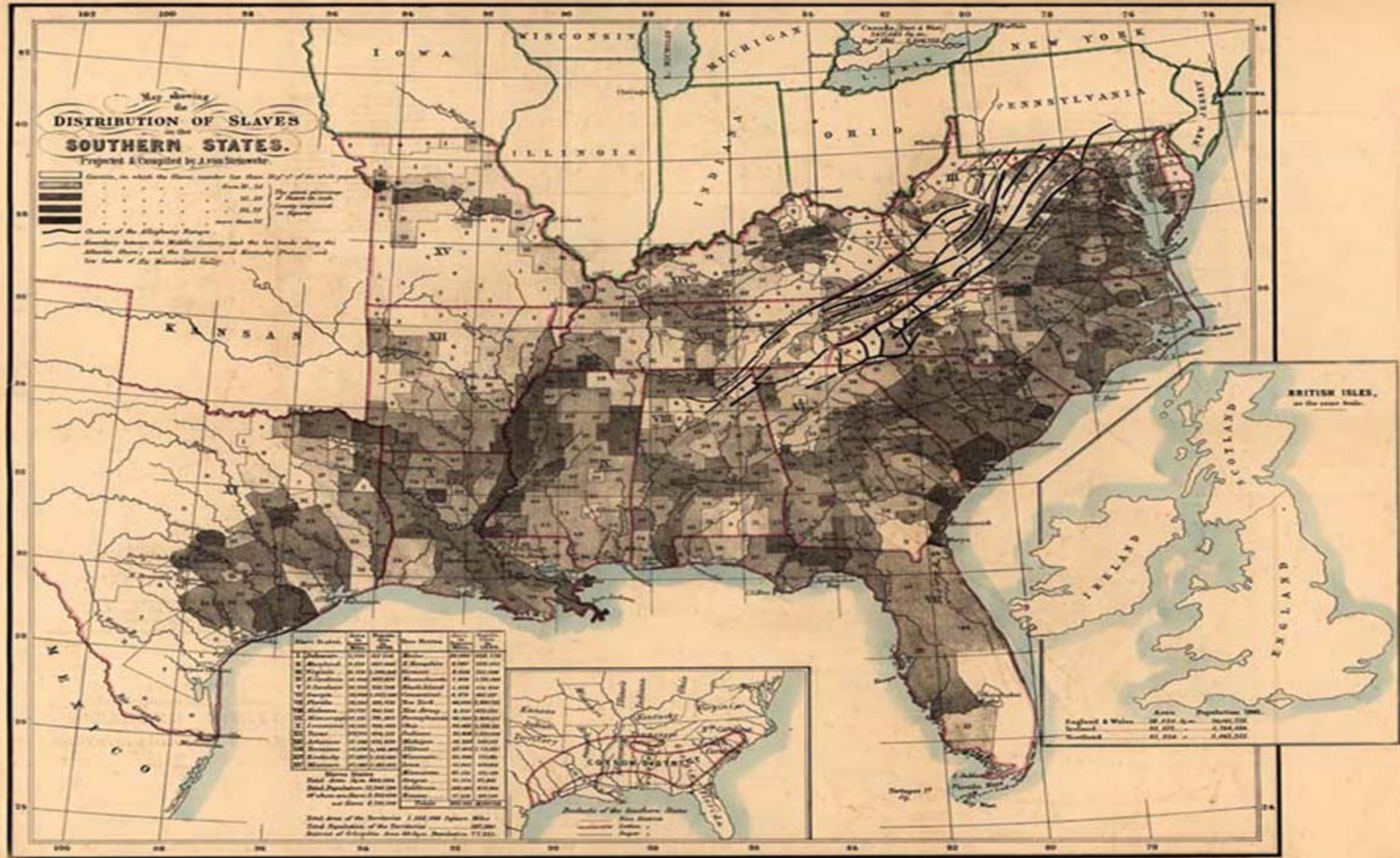


Map showing the
